

IDAHO AGCREDIT EDUCATIONAL NATIVE AMERICAN SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Application Eligibility Requirements

1. All applicants must be of Native American descent residing in Idaho AgCredit's territory. A Native American person is one having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who maintains tribal affiliation. Documentation to be provided.
2. Applicant must plan to obtain any type of agricultural focused full time post-high school education. Preference will be given to applicants planning to pursue a career as a part-time or full-time farmer or rancher in AgCredit's territory
3. Application must be completed in full and accompanied by all required attachments by **March 15, 2025**.
4. All applicants must be a student in "good standing" with the secondary or post-secondary educational institution in which they are now enrolled, as evidenced by a recent transcript or grade report which shows the cumulative GPA.
5. Two letters of recommendation must accompany all applications.
6. Age or gender will not be factors of eligibility.
7. Scholarships will be awarded with enhanced consideration given to applicant's service to their community, agricultural involvement/experience, scholastic performance, and fields of study related to agriculture.
8. Scholarship awards and amounts are at the sole discretion of the Idaho AgCredit Scholarship Committee.
9. Individuals receiving scholarships will need to provide permission to be included in association advertising.
10. Those awarded Scholarships will provide proof of enrollment or acceptance to the College/Technical School specified in the application prior to Idaho AgCredit delivering the award to Applicant. Applicant must be a part-time or full-time student as defined by the College/Technical School.
11. Applications may be uploaded via web-site or delivered to any local Idaho AgCredit Office.
